Councillor John Ogle gave a short report to the meeting covering the following: -Broadband for Fledborough Road repairs and improved road safety features in Nottinghamshire VIAEM update.

Cllr. Ian Oakden thanked Cllr. Ogle for his help with the Broadband issue.

Cllr. Booth asked who was responsible for the upkeep of Ash Close in Dunham on Trent which was considered to be in poor condition and a visibility issue.

The Clerk was asked to investigate and report back in due course.

Councillor Keith Isard advised that a site visit was to take place at Roberts Close to decide what remedial works would be undertaken to address the flooding issue there.
